Inside Bed Cabinets

Step 1: Remove adjustable shelves and identify the CENTER cabinet. The center cabinet is DEEPER than the right and left cabinets.

Helpful hint: the right and left cabinets are interchangable (same dimensions). If your bed has only two cabinets, or they are all the same depth the cabinets can be used in any position.

Step 2: Locate the studs in your wall where the cabinets will be installed.

Step 3: Install the right cabinet first by positioning it all the way to the right and top of the bed cabinet. Anchor the cabinet to your wall using the 3 1/2"screws provided. One screw in the nailer corresponding to the studs in your wall.

Repeat the process for the left cabinet next.

Step 4: Slide center cabinet between the right and left cabinets allowing the face frame to overlap the right and left cabinets and attach it to the wall as described above.

Step 5: Cover the screw heads with adhesive screw head covers provided.

Helpful hint: If you are unable to find one stud per cabinet, you can anchor one cabinet to its neighbor cabinet (provided it is anchored to a stud) using the 1 1/4" gold screws provided. The left and right cabinets can also be anchored to the side board of the bed using the 1 1/4" screws as well.
